3	College adopted the ERP my classboard.com for LMS, Library management, Accounts Management etc a part from Gsuite Enterprise to increase the usage of ICT for teachers and students.
4	College conducted the International conference on Intelligent Semantics. ISIC2021 in collaboration with NIT Kurukshetra & university of Lubeck Germany. ISIC 2021 had attracted 4 top-shot researchers as advisory. The conference committee had taken due care in finalizing the three keynote speakers and the eight invited speakers for the conference. They were diversified across the whole world and are eminent experts in their field. The conference had 14 special sessions with overall 34 chairs. There were 21 members as chairs in the main conference organization and approximately 200 technical program committee members from various countries all around the world. ISIC 2021 showcased one workshop three tutorials . The conference depicted a high geographic diversity with members from around 40 different countries and high gender diversity with more than 35% women in its organization. ISIC 2021 was conducted in Hybrid mode (Face-to-face and Online) . Though the COVID-19 pandemic hits this initiative to some extent, we have brought out a quality proceeding. Furthermore, the semantic intelligence technologies maintain synergy with a wide spectrum of applications and a broad range of domains. In order to motivate the upcoming researchers who have a potential to grow, various special sessions have been organized by chairs across 17 different countries with not more than 2-3 papers from any same organization. The Conference was divided into three tracks, namely the Research Track, the Trends and Perspectives Track, and the Applications and Deployment Track.

	The Institute has conducted a one Week Online Faculty Development Programme on Blended Learning: Tools for Teaching & Research in Media, Management and Technology from July 20-25, 2020. The event organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college emphasised on integrated blended learning in order to optimise online and offline mode of teaching so as to deliver the best teaching experience, in these unprecedented times.
